Mr. Williams stated it would be a great opportunity to put fliers up at Forsyth to promote the event. Ms. Clark discussed who would be setting up at the high school and at the park the day before. Mr. Williams inquired if there was someone that would be singing the National Anthem. Ms. Clark stated they did not at this time. Mr. Williams stated he would contact someone.
