Wastewater Treatment Facility Project Update

The membrane bioreactor upgrade is going well, the installation of the membrane bioreactors will be commencing very soon. The network of piping and pumps are being installed; once this framework is installed, the basins will be populated and begin operation. The subsequent upgrade (Phase II) is at fifty percent (50%) completion. If you are traveling on the North 100 West road between now and August 2015, please watch for slow traffic and heavy equipment. City Council Vacancies

This year there will be two council seats opening up on the Jerome City Council. The terms are for four years starting January 2016.

Anyone at least 18 years old on Election Day, a citizen of the United States, and residing within the city limits of the City of Jerome for thirty days is qualified to register to vote. Once you are registered to vote you are an eligible candidate. You must be registered to run for office. The first day a candidate may file a Petition of Candidacy to run for city council is Monday, August 24th.
